ScadaPhone – ScadaPhoneMakeInstall.Exe

Purpose:

This note explains the use of the ScadaPhoneMakeInstall.exe program. This program creates a custom install program for ScadaPhone.

Applies To:

All versions of ScadaPhone

Note:

ScadaPhoneMakeInstall.exe is used to create a ScadaPhone install program just like the factory installation program. It can include a custom sample project and all system files necessary for ScadaPhone operation. It is intended to be used by distributors or large customers who wish to develop a custom ScadaPhone project configuration and then make an install program for the end user to use to install ScadaPhone with the custom project.

Requirements:

- ScadaPhoneMakeInstall.exe and ScadaPhoneInstallStub.exe must be in the same directory that ScadaPhone.exe is run from. A Zip file named SampleProject.zip must also be in this directory. This Zip file should contain all the files in the desired custom project directory and any subdirectories.
- All of the System files must reside in a subdirectory of the program directory named 'SystemFiles'
- If you are including a project, zip all the files in the project directory to a file named SampleProject.zip. Do not include subfolders or additional folder information when zipping this file. Place this file in the in the same folder as ScadaPhone.exe.

Operation:

Double click on 'ScadaPhoneMakeInstall.exe', or create a shortcut to it and click on it. The program will display a small form with a button labeled 'Make Install Program' Click on this button to start the process. The program's progress will be displayed. Upon completion it will display the path and name of the install program which has been created. Actually two files are created, ScadaPhoneInstall.exe and ScadaPhoneInstall.zip. You will want to distribute only ScadaPhoneInstall.exe which is the actual ScadaPhone install program.

When ScadaPhoneInstall.exe is run, and you have included the SampleProject.zip file, it will be placed in the "./Projects/Sample" folder and will be the default project when ScadaPhone is first started
